Plain Language Explanation:

Pursuant to Section 2-105(B)(1) of the Illinois Human Rights Act [775 ILCS 5/2-105(B)(1)], every State executive department, State agency, board, commission, and instrumentality must comply with the Department's Rules and Regulations concerning equal employment opportunities and affirmative action. The amendment clarifies the information and documentation required to prepare a hiring or promotion monitor, and identifies the procedures that state executive agencies must follow when submitting the monitor to Central Management Services.
